INVITATION

Dear casting sport and flycasting friends!

Estonian Casting Federation and Tallinna Kalaspordi Klubi are happy to invite you to participate in Tallinn Indoor Cup 2020, the casting and flycasting tournament held on 18. April 2020 in Sõle Football Hall in Tallinn, Estonia.



Comparing with previous years, the venue has changed. Our aim is to bring casters from different styles and different countries together and tighten the sport friendship.



The venue: Sõle Football Hall

Court: 103*66 m, height 21,5m. Artificial grass.

The World Cup tournament: Pentathlon for men and ladies

Tallinn Indoor Cup: #1 fly accuracy, #2 fly distance, # 5 plug distance single hand for all classes. Combination of events #3- #5 for veterans. Pentathlon for juniors.

The flycasting disciplines: Ev1 - Trout accuracy, Ev2- Trout distance, Ev3 - Seatrout distance, Ev4 - salmon distance + all round. The all round points are calculated as follows: Ev1 - points, Ev2 – sum of two longest casts, Ev3 and Ev4 – both longest cast multiplied by 1,5.

For distance events, only flies, made from yarn/wool, are allowed.

Other casting disciplines:

- **ESS Kalev championship** in Arenberg (play-off “swedish” format for the 16 best casters by the qualification results of #3). The best junior, lady and veteran are awarded by medal.
- **Superskish play-off** competition with participation of 16 best casters will follow the official competitions. The best junior, lady and veteran are awarded by medal.

Declines from the rules:

- The events #1 and #2 will be casted from podiums with size of 1x2 meters;
- Due to safety reasons, it is prohibited to touch the ceiling with a plug in plug distance event. Relevant cast will be evaluated as “o”.

The Classes:

The World Cup: For World Cup, veteran men and men will be counted in the men class and the veteran ladies and ladies will be counted in the ladies class.

Tallinn Indoor Cup: juniors (boys and girls, born 2002 or later), adults (men and ladies) and veterans (60+ for men and 55+ for ladies) in Tallinn Indoor Cup. A class would be ranked if at least 5 persons in a particular class declare their participation by 15 March.

Schedule: The venue will be open for court building and practice on Friday, 17. April from 20:00 to 22:00. The start of competitions on 18 April is at 8:30. The exact schedule depends of the number of participants and will be specified by 15 March. The price giving ceremony with banquet is estimated at 20:00 in the Park Inn by Radisson Meriton Conference & Spa Hotel Tallinn.

Transport: Transport to and from airport, harbour and hotel is organized upon request by maxi taxis as always. Transport between the hotel and venue is organized by bus.

Accommodation: We suggest Park Inn by Radisson Meriton Conference & Spa Hotel Tallinn <https://goo.gl/maps/61LEKuLzCywSLB7g7> . You can book the room for special rate of 65€ for single room/night or 75€ for double/twin room (incl breakfast and SPA) through link <https://lingid.ee/wyfsN> until 15 March. Please feel free to modify the dates, if necessary and use the passcode IDCUP. Breakfast and free usage of saunas, spa and gym are included. Accommodation for prearranged referees will be covered by organizers.

Lunch: Served in the hall in thermal boxes with price of 8€. Please let us know if there are some special requirements.



Registration: The deadline for indicative registration is 28 February 2018. Please specify the number of participants, disciplines and class. The final deadline is 20 March (see Annex I). Please register at allanlahi@gmail.com.

Cost: 50€ per participant for all casting events together or 10 € for single event; 10€ per event in flycasting events; 25€ for banquet. Bank transfers and usage of Transferwise with no losses in currency conversion are available.
